

LIVIN' LITE 5.0

Livin' Lite Recreational Vehicles have been producing ultra-lightweight campers for the last five years. The Quicksilver line consists of three sizes of campers and two additional models with an 8 foot aluminum deck for transporting an ATV or other toy. The smallest of the Quicksilvers is the 5.0, little brother to the 8.0 and 10.0, which represents the length in feet of the trailer box.

The Quicksilver lineup is the closest to the traditional tent camper, but far from the ordinary. The 5.0 opens to a ten-foot interior that sleeps four and weighs 500 pounds unloaded. Surprising to most who view the 5.0 for the first time is the roominess and comfort level of such a compact camping unit. All aluminum and composite construction highlights the Quicksilver family, resulting in a longer-lasting product.

Young families are attracted to the Quicksilver because of the spaciousness of the opened camper. With a 6-foot 4-inch interior height there is no crawling around in these units. It's tough to find an RV weighing less than 1000 pounds (the 10.0 model) which can accommodate six people comfortably. Retired couples also find the comforts and ease of towing of the Quicksilvers an alternative to a full-size RV. The ease of set-up is doable by nearly all physical abilities and ages. Hunters will appreciate the newest exterior design of Real Tree Camouflage. For others, the Quicksilver has several color options to choose from.

These wood-free crossovers are equipped with more interior components than others, some optional, some standard: cabinets, 12-volt power supply, storage compartment/TV stand that can house an air conditioner, portable range, clip on lights and fans, hand pump sink, and more. These additions bring more of an RV flavor to the camper, but the basics of camping are still the goal. The interior seats are covered in marinegrade vinyl, adding to the long lasting and durability of these units. Livin' Lite's aim is to provide as much RV comfort in a simple, ultra-lightweight trailer towable with whatever vehicle the new Quicksilver owner already owns.

With the ease of towing with small vehicles and affordable price tag, the Quicksilver offers realistic possibilities for both tenters wanting to get off the ground and for the RVer who wants to shed some of the expenses of owning and towing traditional RVs, but keep a few of the RV comforts.
