

Livin Lite to Introduce New Truck Camper at RVIA

Livin Lite RVs will introduce a new CampLite truck camper as well as new features to its CampLite series at next week's 49th RV Trade Show in Louisville, Ky.

Livin Lite is expanding its aluminum and ultra-light weight CampLite truck camper series to include the new 6.8 model, which is designed specifically for short-bed, half-ton trucks, according to the company. The unit is fully self-contained with all the amenities of a much larger truck camper, but fits a 6-foot, 6-inch bed with no overhand. The 6.8 unit also includes an exterior garage area that can hold a small generator, and a number of other tools and items on its hanging rack system.



On the CampLite travel trailer, the manufacture will now offer a new ORBIT front profile, which combines with the painted exterior metal to form a "one-of-a-kind" exterior look.



Livin Lite will now start offering the "Wood Look" interior package on its cabinets featuring Azdel composites. With the package, the aluminum cabinetry will feature a wood grain pattern.

"While our all aluminum construction remains the foundation of our long-lasting, ultra-lightweight design, we have had some customers ask for a richer interior look that only wood can provide," said Scott Tuttle, president of Livin Lite. "The Azdel product, with a realistic wood grain image, allowed us to offer that warm, wood-look interior while not having to sacrifice our all-aluminum/no-wood philosophy. In fact, our customers can still wash their CampLite out with a hose and not hurt it."
